Clinton Cook called the special board meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

I. <u>CEO Candidate Interviews</u>

The interview process was discussed. Board members were provided a list of interview questions.

The following candidates were interviewed by the full board:

- Nahan Hough (10:00 a.m. 11:00 a.m.)
- Lorenzo Suter (11:30 a.m. 12:30 p.m.)
- Travis Roderick (1:00 p.m. 2:00 p.m.)

After the interviews were conducted, employees were invited to share their thoughts, and each board member shared their opinion about the candidates.

After discussion, the board voted by ballot to determine how many candidates to invite for in-person interviews. Seven board members voted to invite all three candidates and five voted to invite two.

A <u>motion</u> to invite the three candidates to appear for a one-day meet and greet/interview was made by Kurt Fredrickson, seconded by Greg Cook. The motion passed unanimously.

Carol Gilbertson made a <u>motion</u> to have Drew Francisco and Sally Sedgwick provide a tour of the facility to the CEO candidates, seconded by Heidi Watson. The motion passed with eight in favor and four opposed.

Teresa Kittridge made a <u>motion</u> to authorize the board chair to negotiate a performance package with a maximum amount of \$300,000, seconded by Gary Erickson. The motion passed unanimously.

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At 4:15 p.m., a **motion** to adjourn the meeting was made by Dan Sursely, seconded by Larry Salmela. The motion passed unanimously.
